What to Do Immediately After a Collision

STOP: It is illegal not to stop, whether you are at fault or not. Failure to stop will result in a fine, demerit points, or criminal prosecution.

Stay calm, ensure your safety, and assess the situation.

- Turn off the vehicle and turn on hazard lights.
- Remain polite, DO NOT make any statements admitting fault <u>or</u> cast blame.
- Check for injuries.
- Keep vehicles where they are. It is recommended that you do not move your vehicles before exchanging information and taking photos as evidence (see below and other side for details). Even then, do not move the vehicle if it is not safe to do so.

3 CALL 911 if:

- Someone is dead, seriously injured, or disoriented.
- You suspect the other driver is impaired of alcohol or mental comprehension issues.

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CALL the non-emergency police line if:

- All drivers can't produce a driver's license AND proof of valid insurance.
- Vehicles are not drivable.
- The damage is more than \$2000 or if there is damage to public property. The operator will assess the situation over the phone and either direct you to wait for police or go to the station to make a statement.

5 Exchange Information with other drivers <u>and</u> any witnesses (see other side for details).

- Think of your safety; do not stand between two vehicles or in front or behind a vehicle at any time.
- ONLY discuss details of the collision with the police, not others involved.

**If police have been called, collect their information as well (name, contact information, report taken).

Take photos of the scene, damages to both vehicles, and road conditions when safe to do so.

- Take photos from different angles.
- If photos are not possible because the person left the scene, sketch a drawing.


Call a tow company if vehicle is not drivable.

8 Reminder: File a collision report at the police station, if:

- The damage to the vehicles appears to be more than \$2,000, and you did not call the police to the scene of the accident.
- Failure to do so could result in a fine.

Call your insurance company to start a claim and wait for further instruction. **Document phone number so it is easily accessible following a collision.
